# Game Notes

**TONIGHT'S GAME** – The Colorado Eagles take on the Idaho Steelheads tonight for the ninth time this season, as the two teams will meet a total of 12 times during the 2017-18 season.

**THE SEASON SERIES** – Colorado is 4-3-0-1 this season against the Steelheads, including a record of 3-1-0-1 in games played at the Budweiser Events Center.

**THE ALL-TIME SERIES** – Colorado sports an all-time record of 28-25-10 against the Idaho Steelheads, including a mark of 18-10-4 in games against the Steelheads at the Budweiser Events Center.

**EAGLES' LAST GAME (2/9)** – Idaho rallied back from a 2-0 deficit in the 2<sup>nd</sup> period to defeat the Colorado Eagles 4-3 in a shootout on Friday. Steelheads forward Brady Brassart notched two goals and the game-winner in the shootout, while Eagles forward Drayson Bowman also netted two goals in the contest. Colorado goalie Lukas Hafner turned aside 37 of Idaho's 40 shots in the game and denied seven of the eight shooters he faced in the shootout.

**OUT OF THE CHUTES-** Colorado has been very successful this season in getting off on the right foot in contests. The Eagles are 23-3-3-1 this year when scoring the game's first goal and have outscored the opposition 53-31 in the opening 20 minutes of play. Through the first 47 games this season, Colorado has a winning percentage of 83.3% in games in which they have scored the first goal. They also boast a record of 19-3-0-1 when leading after one period.

**TOTALLY RAD-** As the Eagles celebrate this evening's "80's Night", it's interesting to note that only three players on this seasons roster were actually alive in the 1980's. Defenseman Jake Marto and Matt Register were born in 1986 and 1989, respectively, while forward Drayson Bowman was also a late arrival to the decade, born in 1989.
