Game Notes

TONIGHT'S GAME – The Colorado Eagles take on the Fort Wayne Komets in Game Two of their Western Conference Final series against the Komets. Colorado defeated Fort Wayne, 3-2 in overtime in Game One to take a 1-0 series lead.

THE PLAYOFF SERIES – Colorado leads the best-of-seven series against the Komets, 1-0. After tonight, the series will shift back to Fort Wayne for Games Three, Four and Five (if necessary).

THE ALL-TIME SERIES – This is the first postseason meeting between the Eagles and Komets, as Colorado went 0-1 against Fort Wayne during the regular season and sports an all-time record of 6-3-1 against the Komets.

EAGLES' LAST GAME (5/12) –Eagles forward Michael Joly netted the game-winning goal 3:25 into overtime to cap off a hat trick that would propel Colorado to a 3-2 victory over the Komets in Game One of the Western Conference Final. Joly scored a shorthanded goal, a power-play tally and an even-strength goal, while goaltender Joe Cannata collected the win in net, stopping 23 of the 25 shots thrown his way.

FAMILIAR TERRITORY- The Eagles enter tonight's Game Two of the Western Conference Final against the Fort Wayne Komets having won six straight games in the 2018 Kelly Cup Playoffs. This is the second consecutive season that the Eagles have reached the Conference Final and it is Colorado's eighth appearance in a Conference Final series in team history. This marks the first ever meeting between the Eagles and Komets in the postseason.

BEING BEAUDIN- Eagles forward J.C. Beaudin leads all ECHL rookies with 13 points and is 2nd in the league with eight goals during the 2018 Kelly Cup Playoffs. The 21 year-old is also tops among the league's first-year players in shorthanded goals (1), plus-minus rating (+8) and game-winning goals (2).The 3rd round draft pick of the Colorado Avalanche comes into tonight's contest having posted four goals and two assists in his last four games.
