GAME NOTES

TONIGHT'S GAME – The Colorado Eagles conclude a six-game homestand with the second of back-to-back matchups with the Coachella Valley Firebirds.

SEASON SERIES – The Eagles are 3-2-0 in the season series against the Firebirds, including a mark of 2-1-0 in games played at Blue Arena.

THE ALL-TIME SERIES – The Eagles own an all-time regular-season record of 8-4-1 against Coachella Valley and are 5-2-0 against the Firebirds in games played in Loveland.

EAGLES' LAST GAME (1/18) – Colorado scored four-straight goals to erase a 3-1 deficit and defeat the Coachella Valley Firebirds 6-4 on Saturday. Six different Eagles found the back of the net, while goaltender Adam Scheel improved to 6-0-0 on the season, making 21 saves on 25 shots. Colorado would finish the night going 1-for-3 on the power play and a perfect 4-for-4 on the penalty kill.

-----NOTES & NUMBERS-----

POINT PRODUCER- Forward T.J. Tynan picked up an assist in the Eagles 6-4 win last night and is now riding a four-game point streak, having generated a goal and four assists in that stretch. The two-time AHL MVP is averaging a point per game over the last 14 contests, posting five goals and nine assists in that span. Tynan is one of just two players in league history to lead the AHL in assists on four separate occasions, including an 84-assist effort during the 2021-22 season with the Ontario Reign. Through 667 career AHL contests, Tynan has dished out 508 assists and amassed 615 points.

BALANCED APPROACH- Colorado currently ranks third in the AHL with an average of 3.51 goals per game and checks in at seventh in the league with an average of 30.8 shots per contest. That drive to the net has not forced the Eagles to sacrifice anything in their own zone, however, as Colorado has only allowed an average of 2.63 goals per game, the fifth fewest in the AHL, while the average of just 27.5 shots allowed per contest ranks ninth in the league.
