

TONIGHT'S GAME – The Colorado Eagles conclude a two-game homestand with the second of back-to-back matchups with the Ontario Reign.

SEASON SERIES – The Eagles are 3-1-0 in the season series against the Reign, including a mark of 2-1-0 in games played at Blue Arena.

THE ALL-TIME SERIES – The Eagles own an all-time regular-season record of 29-17-1 against Ontario and are 16-9-0 against the Reign in games played in Loveland.

EAGLES' LAST GAME (2/28) – Colorado goaltender Trent Miner stopped all 29 shots he faced to claim his first shutout of the season, as the Eagles defeated the Ontario Reign 4-0 on Friday. Forward Jake Wise led the offensive attack with a pair of goals, while fellow forward Tye Felhaber posted two assists. The win saw Colorado net an even-strength goal, a shorthanded goal, a power play tally and an empty-netter.

RIGHT AT HOME – Colorado has enjoyed a dominant run this season at Blue Arena, as the Eagles are not only tied for the most home wins in the Western Conference with 19, they have also put up more goals on home ice (115) than any other team in the league. Additionally, Colorado is ranked second in the AHL in home power-play production at 24.5%. The Eagles have gone 11-0-1 at home when leading after the first period and 18-1-1 when carrying a lead into the second intermission at Blue Arena.

OLD MacDONALD- Defenseman Jacob MacDonald notched an assist in the Eagles 4-0 win over Ontario last night and leads Colorado with 21 goals on the year. Those 21 goals not only establish a new career high, but are also tops for all AHL defensemen, while his 38 points rank second among the league's blueliners. In addition, MacDonald is third among all AHL skaters with 10 power-play goals this season. Over his last eight games, the 2025 AHL All-Star has notched seven goals and four assists.
