GAME NOTES

TONIGHT'S GAME – The Colorado Eagles conclude a four-game homestand with a matchup against the Coachella Valley Firebirds in the second game of a two-game set.

SEASON SERIES – Colorado leads the season series 1-0 after claiming a 5-0 victory over Coachella Valley last night.

THE ALL-TIME SERIES – The Eagles own an all-time regular-season record of 6-2-1 against Coachella Valley and are 4-1-0 against the Firebirds in games played in Loveland.

EAGLES' LAST GAME (11/5) – Colorado goaltender Kevin Mandolese stopped all 25 shots he faced, earning his first shutout of the season, as the Eagles defeated the Coachella Valley Firebirds 5-0 on Tuesday. Defenseman Calle Rosen notched a goal and two assists in the win, while forward Mark Senden added a goal and an assist. Colorado carried the momentum on specialty teams, finishing 2-for-4 on the power play and 3-for-3 on the penalty kill.

SHOOT IT- Coachella Valley comes into tonight's game ranked second in the league with an average of 35 shots per contest. On the other end of the ice, Colorado is tied for the top spot in the AHL, surrendering an average of just 25 shots per game. The Firebirds put up 48 shots against Bakersfield last Friday, which is the third-most in the league this season. Interestingly, the Eagles held Coachella Valley to just 25 shots last night.

BACK SUPPORT- Eagles defenseman Jacob MacDonald leads Colorado in goals and is tied for the team lead with eight points. His four goals rank second among all AHL blueliners, while he sits third among the league's defensemen in points through his first seven games. MacDonald has only been held off the scoresheet twice in his first seven games of the season. A two-time AHL All-Star, the veteran blueliner has led the AHL in goals on two different occasions, finishing with 16 tallies during the 2019-20 season and 20 goals during the 2017-18 campaign.
